

PRIMARY PUPILS SAID THEY KNOW HOW TO SHOW RESPECT TO THEIR FRIENDS AND OTHER PEOPLE





THEY REFERRED TO TIMES IN SCHOOL WHERE THEY HAVE LEARNED HOW TO BE RESPECTFUL, SUCH AS IN LESSONS AND ASSEMBLIES.

SOME SAID IT IS DIFFICULT FOR TEACHERS TO SPOT AND STUDENTS AREN'T USUALLY FORTHCOMING WITH INFORMATION.

OTHERS THOUGHT THAT TEACHERS DON'T TAKE BULLYING SERIOUSLY ENOUGH AND THIS CAUSES YOUNG PEOPLE TO SUFFER IN SILENCE.

OF PRIMARY PUPILS SAID THEY KNOW HOW TO STOP BULLYING IN THEIR SCHOOL.






HERE'S A COMMENT FROM ONE OF THEM:




