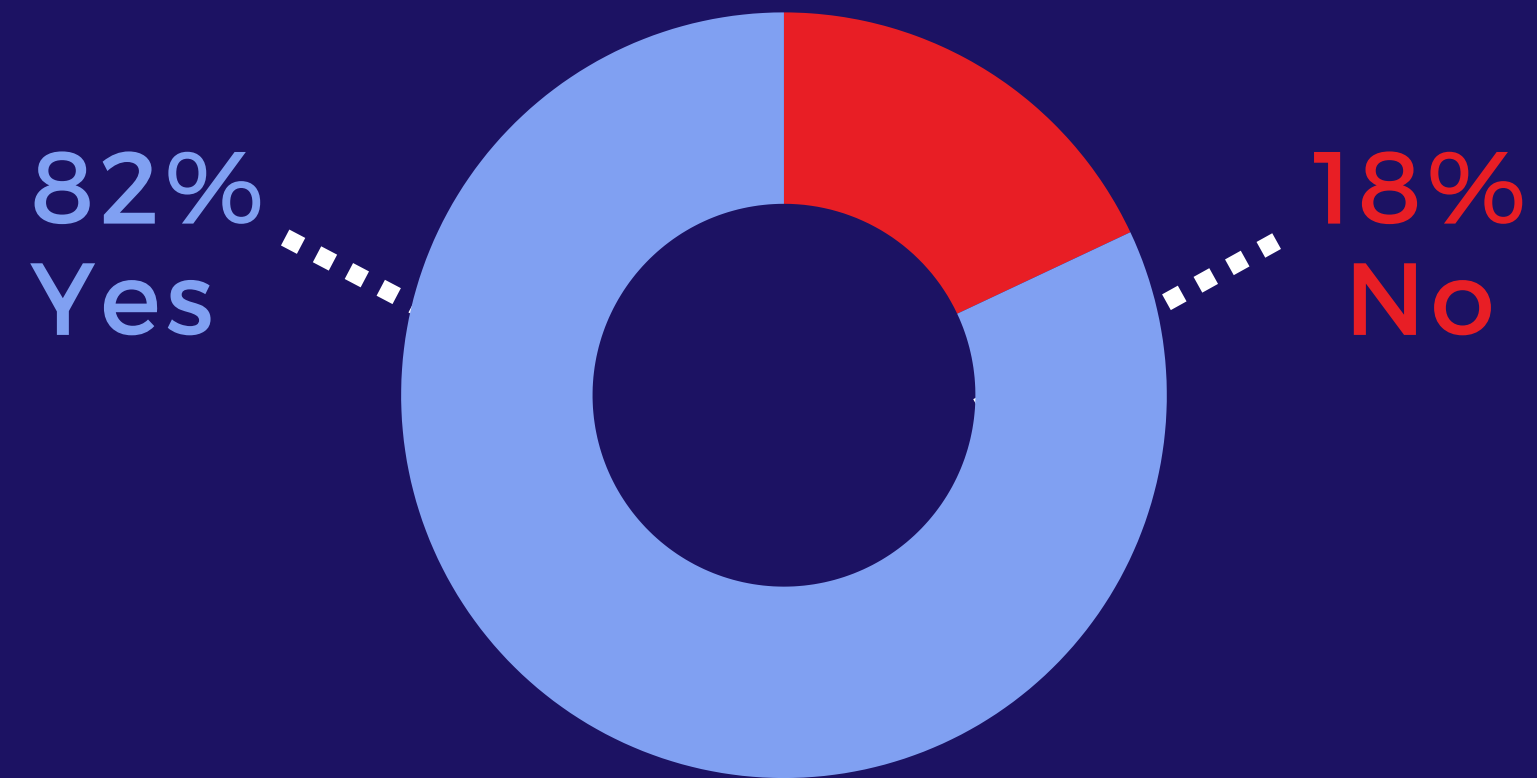

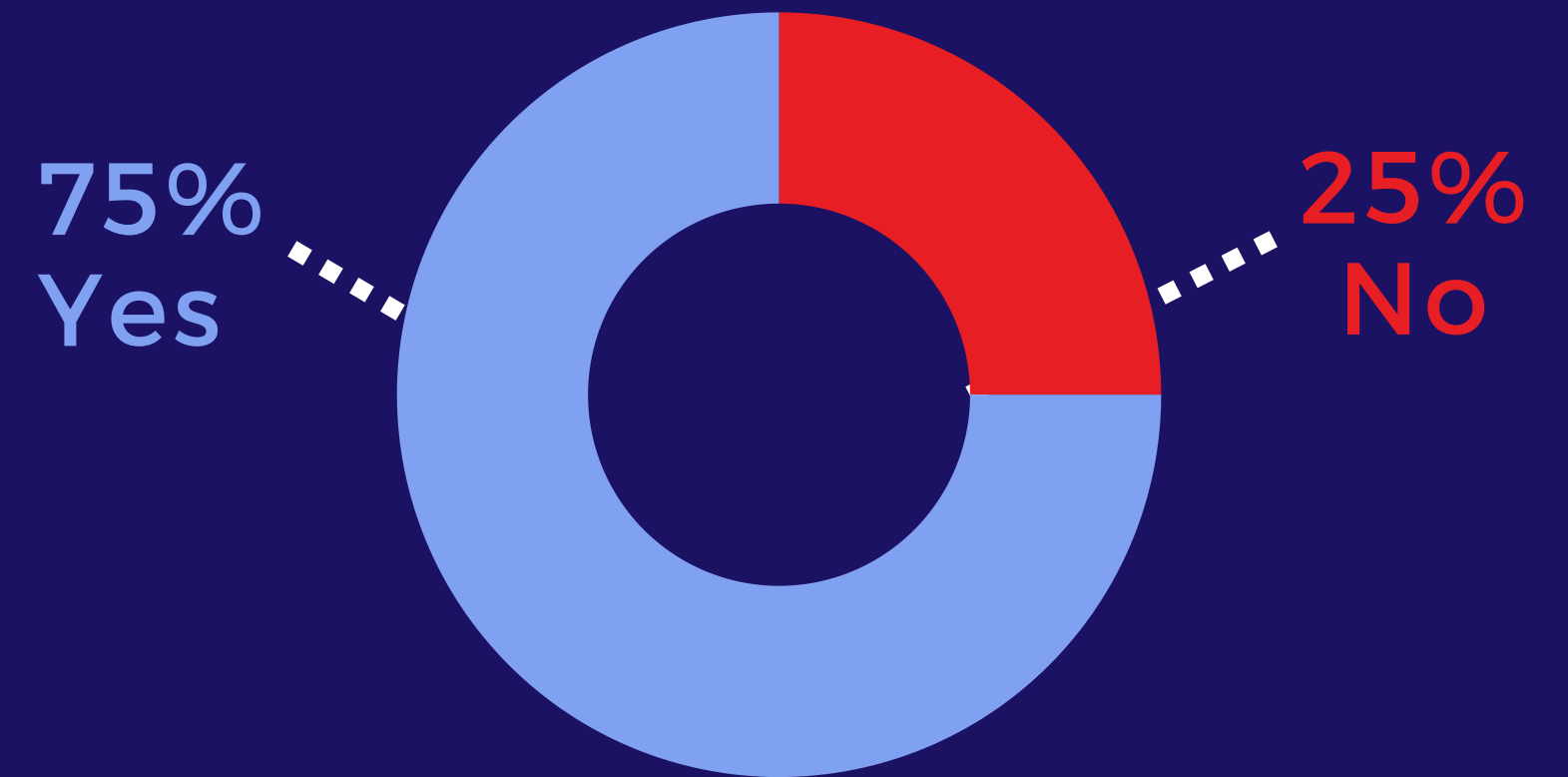

AGE 5-7

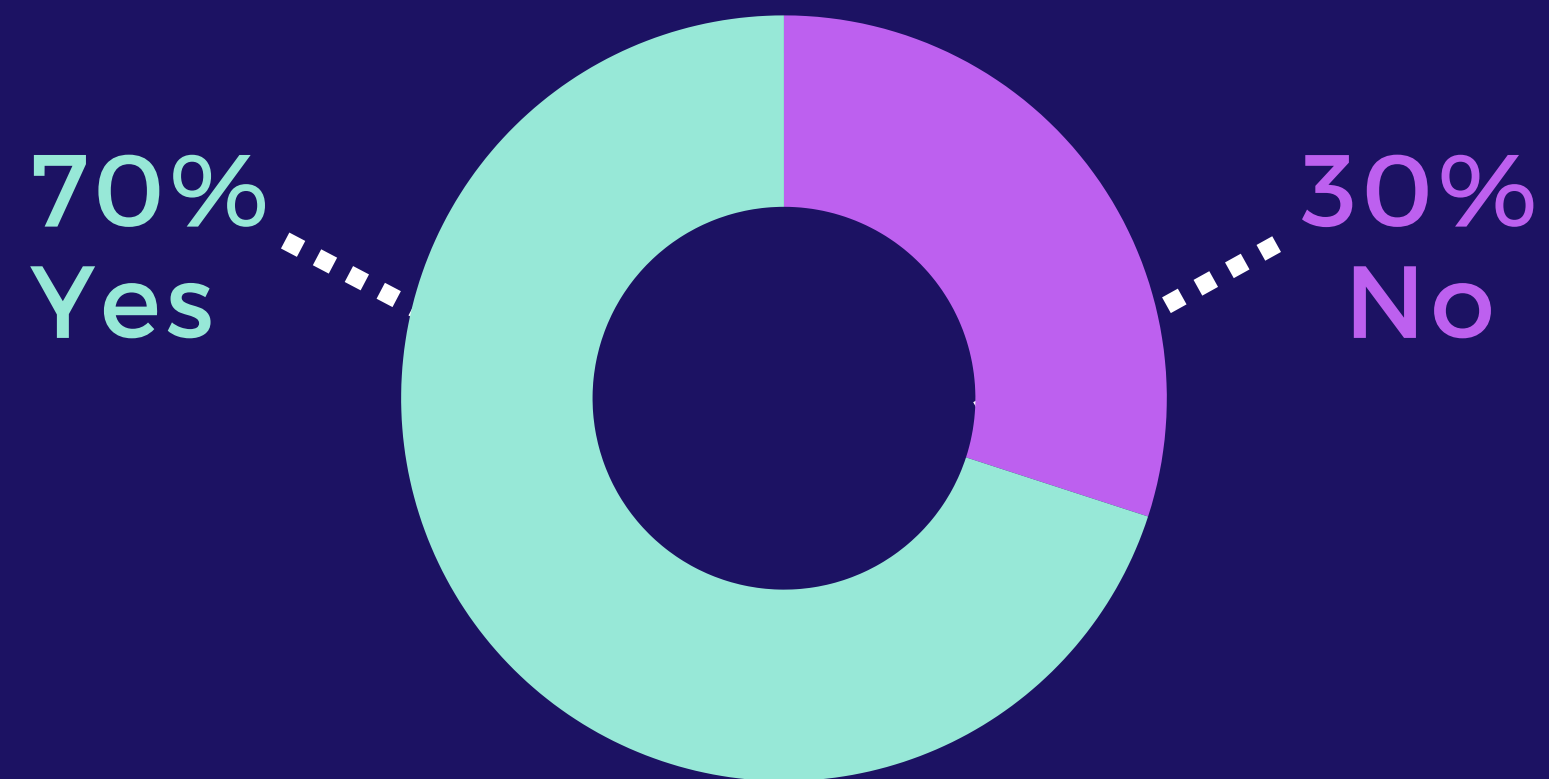

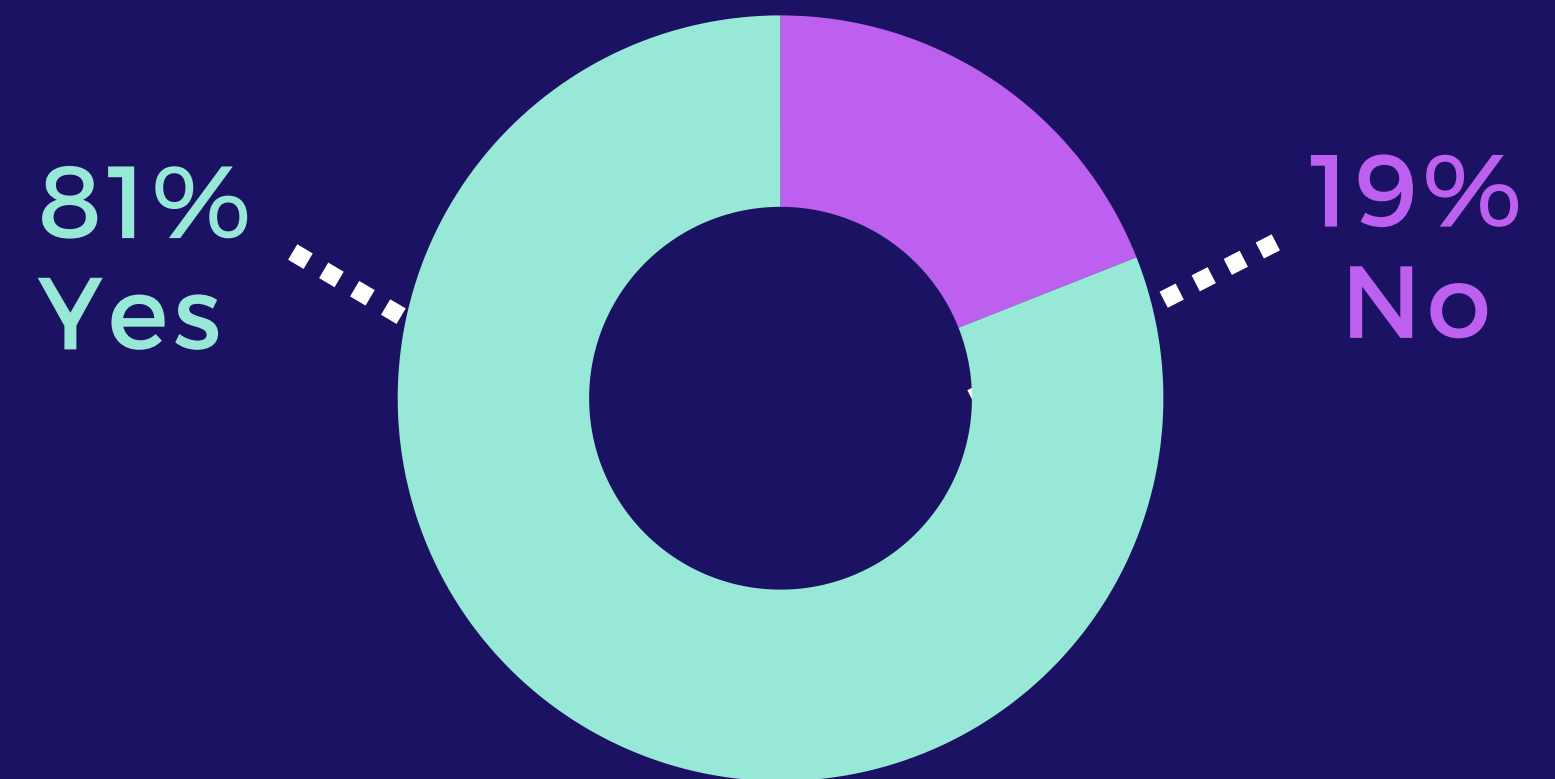

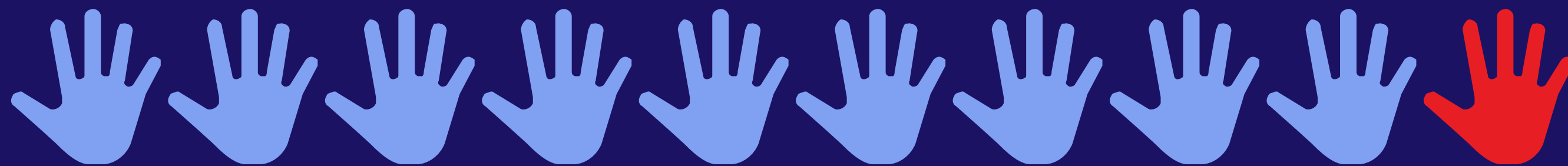

BULLYING SERIOUSLY ENOUGH



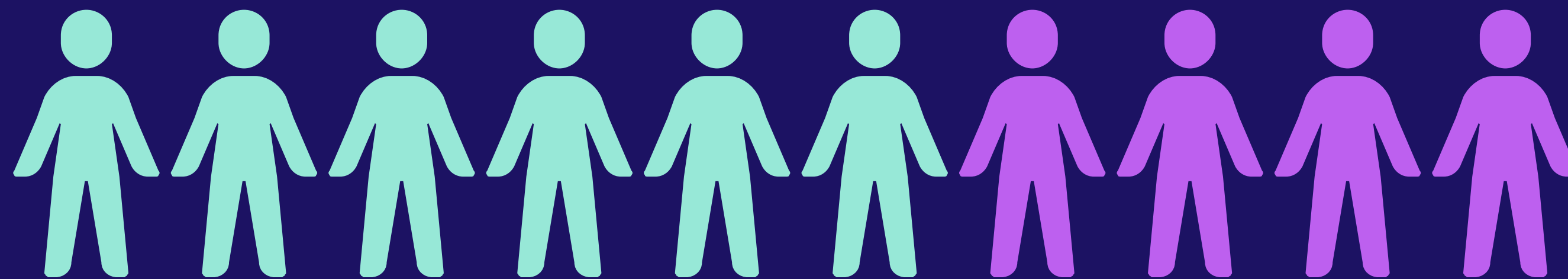


SECONDARY: DO SCHOOLS TREAT BULLYING SERIOUSLY ENOUGH?

SOME SAID IT IS DIFFICULT FOR TEACHERS TO SPOT AND STUDENTS AREN'T USUALLY FORTHCOMING WITH INFORMATION.

OTHERS THOUGHT THAT TEACHERS DON'T TAKE BULLYING SERIOUSLY ENOUGH AND THIS CAUSES YOUNG PEOPLE TO SUFFER IN SILENCE.

SECONDARY STUDENTS SAID YOUNG PEOPLE KNOW
WHAT TO DO WHEN THEY SEE SOMEONE BEING BULLIED

HERE'S A COMMENT FROM ONE OF THEM:

"WE KNOW HOW TO STOP BULLYING IN SCHOOL BY
STANDING UP TO THE PERSON WHO IS BULLYING AND
TELLING A TRUSTED ADULT. IT'S REALLY IMPORTANT TO
TALK TO SOMEONE ELSE IF YOU NEED MORE HELP OR
THINK IT NEEDS TO BE TAKEN MORE SERIOUSLY."

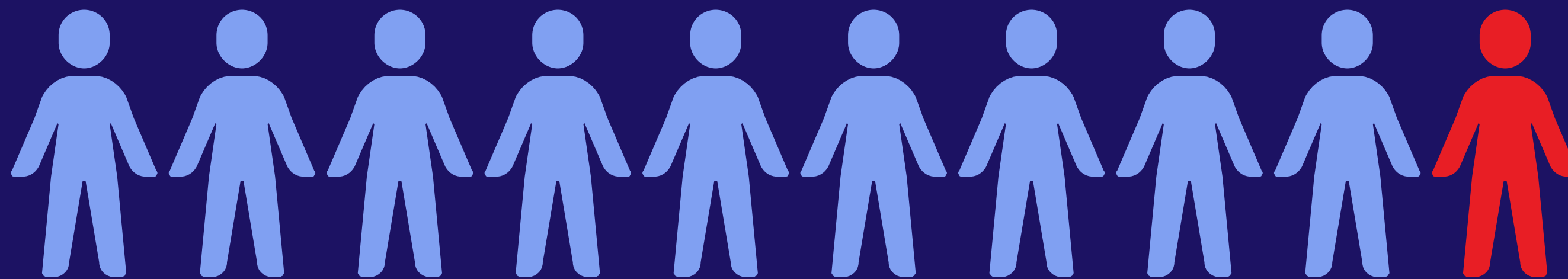

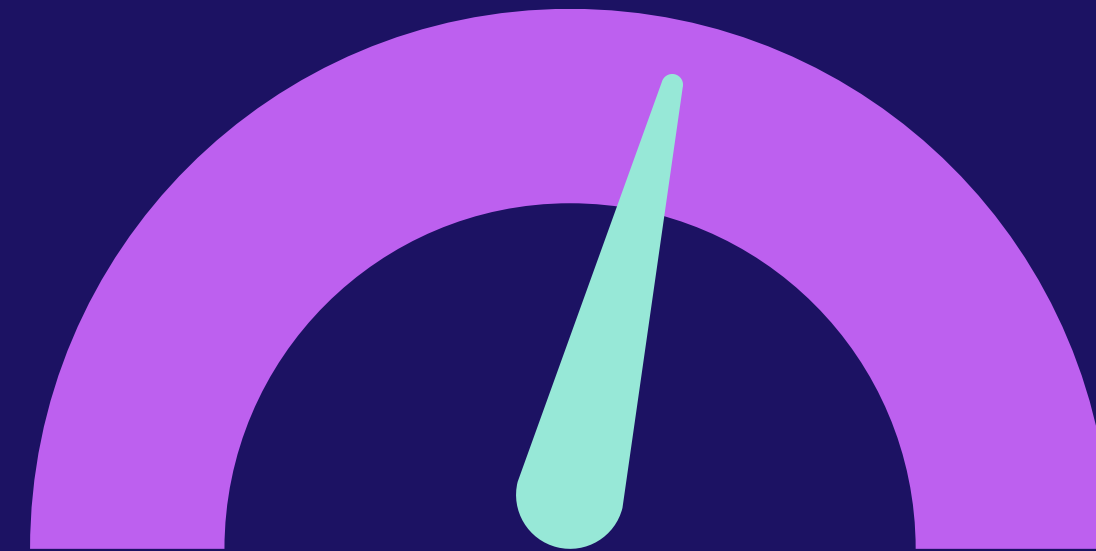
**LOTS OF PUPILS SAID IT'S

57%

SHOULD BE CLASSIFIED AS ASSAULT

OF SECONDARY STUDENTS SAID IT
ISN'T POSSIBLE TO COMPLETELY
ERADICATE BULLYING

AS WE CAN'T CONTROL THE
